HOMEWORK:

Homework will be given several days a week. You are expected to complete all homework assignments. Each assignment must have your name, date, and assignment at the top of your paper. It is to include all work. Credit will not be given just for answers!!! All homework is due at the beginning of the class period.

Homework will be graded on the effort shown, using a four point system:

- 4 points – if the entire assignment is attempted with all work shown
- 3 points – if more than $\frac{1}{2}$ is attempted with all work shown
- 2 points – if $\frac{1}{2}$ is attempted with all work shown
- 1 point – if less than $\frac{1}{2}$ is attempted with all work shown
- 0 pts – if not attempted or only answers are given

***Homework will be randomly collected and graded at least once a week
