Content

- Will be chosen and/or designed based on the individual needs of each student. When choosing content, consideration will be given to each student's current level of functioning as demonstrated through observation, interviews and standardized assessments such as the Washington State Life Skills Inventory Independent Living Assessment Tool and Ohioś Employability and Life Skills Assessment.
- Instruction will be differentiated with multiple entry points for diverse learners. The low ratio of teacher to students, in this class provides for each student's individual needs to be met and for the lesson to change to meet the needs of individual learning styles as the lesson progresses.

Topics will include the following:

- Review career goals and determine steps necessary for attainment.
- Identify transferable career skills and design alternate career plans.
- Use precise language and domain-specific vocabulary to inform about or explain the topic.

- Be able to complete a job application.
- Be able to create a resume.
- Be able to research various jobs.
- Be able to participate in a mock interview.
