Content

- Will be chosen and/or designed based on the individual needs of each student. When choosing content, consideration will be given to each student's current level of functioning as demonstrated through observation, interviews and formal and informal assessments.
- Instruction will be differentiated with mulitple entry points for diverse learners. The low ratio of teacher to students in this class provides for each student's individual needs to be met and for the lesson to change to meet the needs of individual learning styles as the lesson progresses.

Skills

- Define: problem solving, consequences
- Identify/list positive consequences
- Identify/list negative consequences
- When presented with a predicament, identify the main problem.
- Determine the size of your problem and whether it warrants assistance from an adult.
- Identify the cause of the problem.
- Generate multiple solutions the solve the identified problem.
- Identify/list the associated outcomes to each solution.
- Define: compromise, respect, agree, disagree
- Identify a situation where a compromise would be the best solution.
- Generate compromises for presented predicaments.
- Define "perspective taking"
- Understand/explain the importance of "perspective taking" when solving a problem.
- Demonstrate perspective taking via role-playing/hypothetical situations.
