Enduring Understandings

Wax based mediums have appealed to artists for centuries due to their resistance to decay, the vividness and brilliance of their colors, and their unique rendering qualities.

Wax based materials for artistry have been traced back to the Greek Golden Age.

Colored pencils are constructed of a wax or oil-based narrow pigmented core encased in a wooden cylindrical case.

Value infused color is the key to creating 3-dimensional form on a 2-dimensional surface.

Colored pencils provide the artist with precise edges for detailed drawing, layering and realistic effects.

Colored pencils must be used through layering light colors on top of dark colors to achieve success.

Essential Questions

How will use value and color to create 3-dimensional forms on a 2-dimensional surface?

How do you know that your drawing has the right value and color with correct placement?

How will you ensure that your completed drawing is finished with fine craftsmanship?

How will you utilize your materials to create desired effects?

How will you incorporate blending and layering techniques to create realistic effects?
