Essential Questions

Content

Structure:

Reinforcement of verb tenses (present, preterit, imperfect, future, conditional, present perfect, present

subjunctive, past subjunctive)

Vocabulary:

To be in a hurry, to make a mistake, owner, blind person, mustache, to cure, beauty, mirror, bandage, etc.

Skills

Identify vocabulary related to the novel *Marianela*

Identify the historical context and geographical setting of the novel

Identify literary terms in order to recall and tell elements of the story

Use vocabulary to interpret novel

Use context clues and surrounding words to comprehend novel

Distinguish the differences between classes in the novel

Predict future events of the novel using prior knowledge from reading

Compare the relationships in the novel with personal experiences or modern examples from television or books

Summarize events from the story

Explain what makes someone beautiful and apply it to the theme of the novel

Demonstrate comprehension of the novel through retelling its events
