Locate the countries of the target language on a map and identify some key geographical features and attractions.

Compare and contrast geographical features of the countries of the target language with your own country.

Describe summer and winter weather.

Tell what you and others did in the past.

Ask others what they did or didn't do in the past.

Tell seasonal changes and weather patterns in the countries of the target language.

Describe a past vacation using vacation activities, resorts, cultural activities, airport, transportation, gift, and souvenir vocabulary.

Discuss cultural events

Discuss vacation activities.

Compare and contrast cultural activities that are popular in the cities of the target language with the activities of your own country.

Invite someone to the museum.

Examine some works of art of popular artists from the countries of the target language.

Express opinions about art.

Tell time using the 24 hour clock.

Discuss cultural differences regarding time.

Read and interpret culturally authentic text to infer meaning.

Restate in the target language descriptions and daily activities from readings.

Use indirect object pronouns when asking and answering questions about shopping on vacation.

Develop an appreciation for Hispanic food.
