## **Course Overview**

This single-semester related-arts course will meet roughly 45 times, and students will apply storytelling techniques learned in ELA classes to the format of play writing. After a brief unit in which students view a film adaptation of an acclaimed play and review plot components and literary elements, students will move on to units about writing skits and short plays, writing full-length plays, and producing scenes from their own original plays. Throughout the course, activities will emphasize process over product, as the ambitious ideal of writing full-length plays will yield varying outcomes from student to student. The critical components of the class will include peer collaboration alongside intensive individual composition.
