Course Overview

This course will help students become well-informed, active, and responsible members of the global community. Students will begin by reflecting upon the world's needs and their responsibility in addressing those needs. Through problem-based learning, students will examine case studies of real-world challenges like sustainability, poverty, and conflict resolution, among others. The course will culminate in a presentation of a student's philosophy of global citizenship--a demonstration of both the student's awareness of global interconnectedness and preparedness for addressing issues of global concern.
