Course Overview

The kindergarten social studies curriculum provides students with a basic understanding of the world around them. Students are working to understand themselves in the context of where they live (basic geographic features, and a basic understandings of town, state, and country), who lives in that world (people in their community) and culturally significant items (American symbols and holidays). Students will also be introduced to a foundational understand of what "history" is and how it informs their understanding of their country. All of these concepts will be built upon throughout their elementary school career.
