Course Overview

The second grade Writer's Workshop curriculum will enhance student understanding of different kinds of writing. Students will extend their basic writing skills they have been developing in the previous year. In narrative writing, children are invited to study authors who record true stories and try to write those stories well. In opinion writing, students are asked to transfer their abilities to write about ideas and now support their ideas with evidence. In informational writing, students will draw on traditional structure and language of science writing to write informational books that teach others. Within the poetry unit, students will hone their voice and writing skills in language development and word choice. Second grade writers will at year's end take their basic skills further in written communication.
