Course Overview

The fourth grade Writer's Workshop curriculum will enhance student understanding of different kinds of writing. Students will extend their basic writing skills they have been developing in third grade. In narrative writing, fourth graders are invited to study authors who record true stories and try to write those stories well. In opinion writing, students are asked to transfer their abilities to write about ideas and now support their ideas with evidence using boxes and bullets. In informational writing, students will write informational books that teach others about a topic on the American Revolution. Within the literary essay unit, students will respond to text by making connections.
