## Course Overview

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The 4th grade Spanish talent curriculum is a continuation of the third grade, focusing on asking and responding to questions. This is an essential skill in learning a language. The fourth grade will be concentrating on formulating and responding to questions using the interrogatives "¿quién?" (who) and "¿dónde/adónde?" (where/to where). They will learn family and places vocabulary. They will also learn grammar skills such as forms of the verb "ser"/"estar" and understanding the difference between the two. This unit allows students to exchange information with others, giving them the opportunity to connect with the Spanish-speaking world.
