Course Overview

The fourth grade talented art curriculum will increase students' understanding of the seven elements of art with an in-depth focus on painting. Students will be introduced to advanced mediums and techniques while creating historical ties to artists throughout history. Students will be challenged by new mediums such as acrylic paint and will learn how to paint on a wide variety of surfaces. Students will begin to take ownership of their art making through artist statements and critiques. Students will learn how to create art with intention. Units will last two marking periods. Lessons within the marking periods will build upon each other to increase students' knowledge of the content. Unit 1 will consist of technique driven lessons to focus and hone students' abilities. Unit 2 will put their skills to work in the creation of a mural installation within the school.
