## Course Overview

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The novice 6th grade curriculum mirrors the Spanish sixth grade curriculum, but covers the material at a slower pace. The assessments used are modified and many are project based. The vocabulary and grammar are practiced using total physical response activities and review games, appealing to many different learning styles. The units covered are Para Empezar: reviewing vocabulary covered in K-5th grade, Actividades Unit: focusing on activities that students like and dislike, Descripciones Unit: covering descriptive words and phrases describing themselves and others and México y España Unit: focusing on the geography, history, traditions and customs of Mexico and Spain. In summary, this curriculum is similar to the Spanish 6th grade curriculum, but the way the material is presented, the pace of the class and the assessments are created to help students that struggle in a typical Spanish class succeed.
