Course Overview

In the 7th grade novice curriculum, students will learn how to describe their classes and schedule in Spanish. They will also learn how to describe their classroom and locate the items in the classroom. This curriculum is similar to the end of the general education 6th grade Spanish curriculum: Realidades 2A and 2B. Students will be introduced to difficult grammatical concepts, such as, Spanish subject pronouns and conjugating verbs. Plenty of time and practice will be put into understanding and mastering these concepts. That is why there are less units covered in 7th grade, then in other years, giving students more time to practice. Students will also learn about the countries of South America. They will learn about their geographical locations, history, traditions and customs.
