Course Overview

In the novice 8th grade curriculum, students will learn about foods and healthy habits. They will learn food vocabulary for breakfast, lunch and dinner and will also be able to describe different ways to maintain good health. This curriculum is similar to the beginning of the 7th grade Spanish curriculum: Realidades 3A and 3B. Students will practice grammar concepts, such as, conjugating the verb "ser", noun/adjective agreement and conjugating "er" and "ir" verbs. The 8th grade curriculum has three units, giving students the time needed to review the grammar. Students will also learn about the Spanish-speaking countries of Central America and the Caribbean. They will learn about their geographical location, history, traditions and customs.
