Unit Overview

In this unit, students will learn family vocabulary. They will learn vocabulary and grammar needed to ask and respond to basic questions about their families. In addition, students will learn the importance of family in Hispanic culture.

Essential Questions

How is the institution of family different in Hispanic culture?

How is the grammar used in family vocabulary different than English grammar?

Application of Knowledge and Skills...

Students will know that...

- Family is very important to Hispanics
- Family means more than just immediate family, it includes cousins, aunts, uncles
- · Many times, grandparents live in the same house and children don't move out until they get married
- Mi is my singular and mis is my plural
- Tienes means you have and tengo means I have
- To ask who a group of people are, use the question, ¿Quiénes son ellos/ellas? (Who are they masculine/they feminine)
- To ask who someone is, use the question, ¿Quién es él/ella? (Who is he or she?)
- To respond to a question about a group of people, use Son followed by the people's names or titles
- To respond to a question about who a person is, say Es followed by the person's name or title

Students will be able to...

- · ask and respond to questions about family, written and orally
- describe the importance of family for Hispanics
- describe who is in their family, orally and written
- · express and recognize family vocabulary, written and orally

Assessments

- Create a family tree and label it in Spanish. Present the family tree to the class in the target language.
- Diagnostic: Other visual assessments

- Formative: Personal Project
- Name and answer questions about the different family members shown on the Smart Board.
- Pre-assessment
- Summative: Written Test
- Using a word bank, label a family tree and answer multiple-choice questions about the family tree. Describe the importance of the family to Hispanics.

Activities

- read a story as a class, focusing on family vocabulary; record familiar vocabulary words and determine what happens in the story
- Interview a classmate, asking questions about his/her family; present the partner to the class
- learn a rap song about family vocabulary
- play charades using family members
