Unit Overview

In this unit, students will express leisure-time activities in Spanish. They will learn how to describe the activities and sports that they like to do. Students will also ask others what activities they like to do. In this unit, students will also learn about popular Hispanic sports.

Essential Questions

Why is soccer an important sport for many Hispanics?

How would you be able to describe what you like to do to a Spanish-speaking friend?

How can this vocabulary be useful when traveling to a Spanish-speaking country?

Application of Knowledge and Skills...

Students will know that...

- Baseball is a popular sport in the Spanish Caribbean
- Both Uruguay and Argentina have won the World Cup twice
- Bullfighting is a popular sport in Spain, but has led to controversy because of the killing of the bull
- Soccer is a popular sport in many Hispanic countries
- Spain won its first World Cup in 2010
- To ask someone if they like a particular activity, say ¿Te gusta..? followed by the activity
- To ask what someone likes to do, say ¿Qué te gusta hacer?
- To ask what sport someone plays, say ¿Qué juegas?
- To express that you do not like an activity, place a no in front of the me gusta
- To respond to the question about the sport one plays, say Yo juego (I play) followed by the name of the sport
- To respond to the question about what one likes to do, say Me gusta (I like) followed by the name of the activity

Students will be able to...

- answer and ask questions about activities, written and orally
- describe activities that they like to do and sports that they play, written and orally
- describe popular Hispanic sports
- express and write activities in Spanish

Assessments

- Activities Test
- Diagnostic: Other visual assessments
- Express in Spanish the activities displayed on the board and answer questions about the activities.
- Formative: Personal Project
- Label the activities illustrated using a word bank and answer multiple-choice questions about the activities. Answer questions about popular Hispanic sports.
- Pre-assessment
- Summative: Written Test
- Who Am I?
- Write a description about oneself, expressing activities that one likes and dislikes and sports that one plays. Exchange and share descriptions for classmates to determine the writer.

Activities





- In Spanish, ask classmates what sports they play. Record their data and create a bar graph.
- In groups of four, describe a given famous athlete in Spanish and have classmates determine the famous athlete based upon the description.

- Create a poster to illustrate ones likes and write sentences describing each picture.
- Play a Bingo review game

Activities to Differentiate Instruction

- create flashcards to assist with vocabulary
- review vocabulary by playing Internet games
- participate in Smart Board activities
- review using a PowerPoint
- watch a video that reviews vocabulary and grammar
