Unit Overview

This unit will introduce activities that are common to students, their families, and their friends. The focus will be on the exchange of information concerning which of these activities are preferred by students and which ones they dislike. An understanding of cultural similarities and differences concerning favorite activities will be presented.

- Complete interactive activities in text "¿Que te gusta hacer?" chapter (pages 25-47).
- Complete corresponding worksheets from Teacher Guided Activities.
