# **Unit 4: Clothing**

### **Unit Overview**

In this unit, students will learn the vocabulary used to name and describe clothing. They will learn to identify the clothing appropriate to wear in the different seasons or according to the weather. Students will also learn about cultural attire that is linked to various Spanish-speaking countries.
