Course Overview

The Bully Prevention Curriculum for grade 5 is the third and final course in a three year sequence of social skills development. The curriculum, *Committee for Children's: Steps to Respect*, is comprised of five units: friendship making skills; recognizing, refusing, and reporting bullying; and the role of the upstander. The units cover essential life skills such as how to make friends; identifying offensive, disrespectful behavior; assertiveness training; conflict resolution; seeking help from authority figures when necessary; the roles students play in bullying situations and the role of a responsible citizen (upstander). Students are encouraged to use these skills on a daily basis to solve conflicts and to expand their cadre of social skills.
