Course Overview

The Pre-K music curriculum is designed to introduce our youngest students to the greater world of music and start them on a path of preparation for musical learning in the future. The curriculum is presented in 4 over-arching units "Music in the World", "Musical Concepts and Skills", "Musical Vocabulary", and "Musical Performance". These units will introduce young students to body movement, musical expressions (with both body and voice), music as an expressive act, and the foundations of vocal music performance. The units are considered "over-arching" because of the nature of the fluidity of musical performance and concepts.
