## Course Overview

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The Kindergarten music curriculum is designed to build on the introductory aspects of music covered in the Pre-K curriculum, while also expanding to a more nuanced understanding. The curriculum seeks to build on concepts such as expanding musical vocabulary, performance skills, continued work with Orff instruments, and introduction to the instrument families. These concepts are introduced in 4 units. The units are presented as "over-arching" due to their fluidity and inherent connection to each other. In music, unlike other subjects, each of these units is co-dependent on the other as they all involve aspects of each unit simultaneously.
