Topic 2.1 Short Story - The goal of this unit is to introduce reading strategies (DRTA) that students will utilize more independently during the novel study.

-Introduce short story (All Summer in a Day) - build background knowledge via pictures and /or videos

| -Introduce new vocabulary within sentences using VKS (vocabulary knowledge scale) |

| -Make predictions based on title of the story and vocabulary sentences - document predictions |
| -Repeated reading - DRTA - (teacher reads first paragraph aloud, stop to discuss, students partner read, then come together as a class and read again) throughout story |
| - Character development of the group of the children versus Margot (draw pictures of how children behave at the beginning of the story and at the end of the story) |
| -Discuss inferencing and how characters might feel at different parts of the story but is not written in the story. (ex. Margot is not part of the group. I feel sad when I am not part of the group. = inference of Margot feels sad). |
| -Review descriptive language - adjectives, adverbs - find examples of descriptive language in the text |
