7. What are some traditional Chinese pastimes?
8. How do Chinese and American pastimes differ?

### Students will have knowledge of

1. Word Order in Chinese - Subject + Time expression + Adv + Verb + Object - 王朋週末常常看电影。
2. tone change – use hobbies – 爱好 àihào as an example
3. 周末 zhōumò – weekend 週 (周)– week/cycle = 星期; 末 – end -expressions for weekdays and weekend
4. The expression of 你週末喜欢做什么? What do you like to do on the weekends?
5. 看 kàn – to see/watch/read; 电视 (电视) diànshì – TV; 电 diàn – electricity 视 shì – vision  
看电视 – to watch TV. Students translate and review A-not-A and 幾 as the question word.
6. **VO** = V+ O verbs – verb + Object actions/activities –  
打球 dǎqiú – to play ball; 打 – to hit; 球 (王 求) – ball. 看电视 – to watch TV. 看 kàn – to see/watch/read; 电视 (电视) diànshì – TV  
唱歌 chàngē – to sing 唱 to sing \_ ; 歌 song 跳舞 tiàowǔ – to dance 跳 to jump \_ 舞 dance \_  
听音乐 listen to music; 听 (听) tīng to listen/hear 音乐
7. The combination of “some” 有的 yǒu de some and 时候 (时) shíhòu moment/time/a duration of time =  
“sometimes” - 有的时候 yǒu de shíhòu = sometimes (Time Exp as adv)
- 8 The application of 常常 chángcháng often (adv); 我週末常常看电影。sub + time exp + adv + VO(action
9. the function of “series comma” – using 和 – 你、我和他。中国、美国、英国和法国。For a series of verbs or adjectives – 我常常打球、唱歌、跳舞。
10. The application of Chinese Word Order – Subject + Adv (Time words/manners....)+Verb+Object
11. The function of conjunction 那 - Connects two sentences - 那 – as “in that case, then” which links the sentences by two speakers

A). Subject is often omitted in Chinese.

B). Pivotal sentence – when the object of the first verb also serves as the subject of the second verb.

C). Brief introduction of the function of a “help verb” such as “want to” plus the VO structure.

12. The expression of 去看一哥外国电影。去 qù – to go 去看 go (and/to) see; 一个 – quantity + measure word; 外国 wàiguó – foreign country

13. 请客 qǐngkè invite/treat someone to ....; play host 客 (客 各) kè guest 客人

我请客。I play host = my treat 你请客? 你请客(嗎)? 是不是他請客? 是小王請客嗎?

14. 昨天 zuótiān yesterday (日 乍 作 / 怎 / 昨); Yesterday/today/tomorrow 昨天/今天 / 明天; last year/this year/ next year 去年 今年 明年

15. 所以 suǒyǐ so/therefore conj 因為/所以 because/therefore;

16. 好吗? Is that OK? - to solicit someone's opinion after giving a suggestion =好不好?

17. The expressions of “Long Time No See” 好久不見 and 你好吗? 不错 búcuò not bad/pretty good

18. The modal verb 想 xiǎng (木 目 心) To think/have a desire to/want to/would like to - 想做什么?

19. 想xiǎng VS喜欢 一想 xiǎng - would like to; have a desire to VS喜欢 – to like to; to be fond of

20. 觉得 觉 jué de to feel/to think; to have an opinion (about.....) -

21. 意思 yìsi meaning noun - 意 (立日心) 思 (田 心); 有意思 interesting adj & 沒有意思 not interesting/boring adj

22. 算了 suànle never mind/forget it; 找 zhǎo 才 戈 to look for; 別人 biérén other people/person 別(的) other adj 我们点别的菜。

23. Applications of only - 只 zhǐ ; 算了 suànle never mind;

Cultural Note: Chinese people's best pastimes such as "Majiang", "Xiangqi". "Weiqi"
