Unit Summary

This unit will teach students that people have to make choices between needs and wants. There are many factors that influence these decisions and some people struggle to meet basic needs. Choice and scarcity influence this decision making. Students will also learn that basic elements of a community's economic system include goods and services. There is a process in which these goods are produced before they are sold at a store. The role of money and savings makes it possible to produce and purchase these goods. Some jobs in our society are service related and people are paid to do these roles. Service provides are important in our society by helping our community run smoothly. For example, police officers provide protection for the members of its community.
