Unit Summary

This unit builds on student knowledge of crafting and pattern. Students will start by reviewing how to weave. They learned how to weave in kindergarten. Students will learn about warp and weft and how to make a paper loom.

- utilize the warp and weft, two components used in weaving, to make a paper loom.

- pattern is a principle of art.
- weaving is a craft that helps define fine motor skills.
- weaving relates to the term opposite.
