Unit Summary

The second grade visual arts program focus's on learning and understanding the New Jersey Visual Art Standards. The principles and elements of design along with art production, history, aesthetics, and criticism will be used to develop the necessary skills for a balanced art education. These areas of art education can be taught for personal understanding and appreciation for everyday functional products and art awareness. In this unit on mixed media, students will learn to use multiple techniques in one finished work of art.
