Unit Summary

In Unit 13, students will learn the sounds made by the digraphs, ch and ph: ch - chorus /k/, ph-phone /f/. Students will also learn silent letter combinations.

What sounds do the digraphs **ph** and **ch** make?
How do I mark sounds and divide syllables in unfamiliar words with digraphs **ph** and **ch**?
How can spelling pattern rules help me with writing?

Students will be able to independently use their learning to:

- read and write words with digraphs ch and ph.
- read and write words with silent letter combinations: wr, rh, gn, kn, mn, mb, gh.

- reading and writing words with digraphs ch- chorus, ph- phone.

- reading and writing homophones: knew, new, knight, night, knows, nose.
