Unit Summary

In this unit, students will learn the words to describe the parts of their face and body as well as review grammar rules related to gender and number in the targeted language. Students will build on previously-learned vocabulary and language functions to communicate about themselves, their friends, teachers, and classroom at the Novice-Mid level of proficiency.
