Unit Summary

In this unit, all students will be able to use a world language in addition to English to engage in meaningful conversation, to understand and interpret spoken and written language. Students will learn expressions for saying greetings, introductions, feelings, farewells, dates and weather expressions. They will build on previously-learned vocabulary and language functions to communicate about themselves, their friends, teachers, and classroom at the Novice-Mid level of proficiency. During Hispanic Heritage month, we celebrate Hispanic heritage and culture.
