
When Dol Have to Wait?

I need to wait in a lot of different places.




I need to wait when my Mom is talking on the phone.










I need to wait when I want to talk to my Dad and he is talking to someone else.

When the timer is done, I don't have to wait any more.












Everyone has to wait sometimes. My friends have to wait when I am playing with something they want.




Learning how to wait is hard to do and takes a lot of practice. Waiting is very important, because when everyone has a turn to talk or play we can all be happy.

I like to run. It's fun to go fast!






I Can run on the playground. It's usually okay to run when I'm playing outside.




It's not ok to run into the street or in a parking lot away from my mom or dad.




It's not ok to run away in a store or building.



Sometimes I feel like running, but it is dangerous to run!




Running in the street could hurt me!

I can be silly and make up a potty dance. This is what it would look like.


This is my potty at home.
