<p>Writer’s Workspace Rubric {My Writing Checklist} {Genre Specific}</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Depending on the genre, can be used to get ideas for mini lessons throughout the writing process. ● Conference/ small group teaching points. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Good writers apply strategies to their writing so that their compositions are comprehensible.
<p>Writer’s Workspace {Writing Traits Minilessons}</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Can be used to get ideas for mini lessons throughout the writing process. ● Models skills that can be applied during writer’s workshop. <p><i>*Writing Traits Minilessons can be formulated to fit in with the Writer’s Workshop model.</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Good writers apply writing skills to strengthen their compositions. (i.e, sentence fluency, word choice, organization).
<p>Workstation Activity Cards {Writing}</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Whole class mini lesson. ● Provides multiple days for writing instruction. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Allows the writer to see sequential steps to the writing process.
<p>Writer’s Workspace Black Line Masters (BLM) {Graphic Organizers}</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Allows for differentiated brainstorming before writing <p><i>* Writers will be able to properly utilize the graphic organizers during the second half of the school year</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Helps writers organize their ideas for writing. ● Teacher models the use of a graphic organizer in order for the student to recreate independently.
