<p>Writer’s Workspace Blackline Masters {Expert Model}</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Teacher can use this as their own writing to model in the teaching section in their minilesson. ● Exposure to the type of writing students will be doing. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Students need to see a well written and completed composition that is a rubric score of a 4.
<p>Writer’s Workspace Blackline Masters {Anchor Papers}</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Models during conferences and small group work. ● Whole class minilesson 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Gives the writer 4 different writing samples with various scores using the same rubric. ● Writers need to comprehend the expectations when applied to the scoring process. ● Use lower level scores (Score of a 1 or 2) to show how to improve the quality of writing.
<p>Writer’s Workspace Blackline Masters {Student Draft Model}</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● During immersion and mentor text. ● Can be used during whole class teaching points. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Good writers need to see a model while writing. ● Use to show how to improve the quality of writing.
<p>Writer’s Workspace Blackline Masters {Revision Checklist}</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Can be used to get ideas for minilessons during the rehearsal/ developing stage and/or the revision stage of the writing process. ● Conference/ small group teaching points. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Good writers read, review, and rewrite their work to make improvements.
<p>Writer’s Workspace Blackline Masters {Editing Checklist}</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Can be used to get ideas for minilessons during the editing stage ● Conference/ small group teaching points. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Good writers edit their drafts so that their compositions are comprehensible. ● Editing is an essential part of the writing process.
<p>Writer’s Workspace Blackline Masters {Writing Rubric}</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Can be used for ideas for mini lessons, conferences, strategy and teaching points. ● Students can use during independent writing to self assess. ● Teacher can use to score writing. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Provides consistency when grading compositions. ● It allows writers to evaluate their work before submitting to the teacher.
