

01 The New Jersey Drivers License System and Testing

Brief Summary of Unit

This unit addresses the knowledge necessary to successfully complete all stages of the process of acquiring a New Jersey Driver's License. The students will know all steps required for each stage of licensure, the restrictions that come with each type of license under the Graduated Drivers License system, and all applicable laws, rules, and regulations for safe driving in New Jersey.
