Brief Summary of Unit

In this unit, students will actively explore the collaborative process of devising original theatre. Building upon foundational physical techniques learned in "Movement for the Actor," ensembles will synthesize research, personal experiences, and socio-political themes to construct cohesive performances. As a culminating assessment, students will conceptualize, rehearse, and perform a fully devised original piece that either deeply investigates their personal identities or confronts critical global issues, moving beyond traditional scripted theatre to empower their own artistic voices.

Standards

Information Literacy

This unit challenges students to locate, evaluate, and use information effectively. Information literacy includes, but is not limited to, digital, visual, media, textual, and technological literacy. Lessons may include the research process and how information is created and produced; critical thinking and using information resources; research methods, including the difference between primary and secondary sources; the difference between facts, points of view, and opinions, accessing peer-reviewed print and digital library resources; the economic, legal, social, and ethical issues surrounding the use of information.

Enduring Understandings

- Collaborative ensemble work is the foundation of devised theatre, requiring a delicate balance of individual creativity, shared responsibility, and group consensus.
- Devised theatre provides a powerful, dynamic platform for artists to challenge, reflect upon, and directly engage with personal identity, as well as broader societal, cultural, and political systems.
- The artistic process of devising, experimenting, synthesizing multiple disciplines, and revising based on peer feedback, is just as valuable as the final product.

Essential Questions

- How can an ensemble create theatre?
- What is devising and what are the ways it works?
- At what point in the creation process should one consider the intended audience?
- How does engaging in theatre significantly enhance intellectual, psychological, social, and spiritual development?
- How does engaging in theatre allow us to be more engaged with political, cultural, and sociological systems?

Objectives

- Students will practice working as an ensemble to create cohesive pieces that honor the work of all involved.
- Students will collaborate on the creation of unique pieces, balancing individual responsibilities with the good of the group.
- Students will establish a unified vision and then work to create a piece that clearly portrays that vision to an audience.
- Students will be able to list performance companies that rely on devising to create their pieces.
- Students will explore devising as both process-oriented and product-oriented.
- Students will create art that attempts to answer fundamental questions about society's ills.

Learning Plan

- Provide a concept for a devised piece and lead the students in creating a piece around this theme
- Provide elements of a piece and lead the students in creating a piece with a centralized theme from these elements.
- Participate in short-form, immediately created and rehearsed theatre.
- Have students propose and ultimately create a piece of theatre intended to address a specific global issue.
- Have students perform personal pieces exploring their individuality and sense of self.

Assessments

- Students will create a piece appropriate for a public audience from a proposed concept/theme.
- Students will create a more abstract piece from assembled elements and short-form creation processes.
- Students will create a collaborative piece intended to address a specific global issue.
- Students will create individual pieces exploring art and music as a part of performance.
