Unit Overview

Students will be able to understand and identify the basic functions of their home town, surrounding areas.

In this unit, students will identify their personal address and city of New Jersey while understanding they are one of 3 major regions of the United States. Students will examine the various landforms and water systems throughout New Jersey that will be important for navigation and recreation.
