Amelia Earhart became the first woman to fly solo across the Pacific Ocean.

- She completed the flight from Honolulu, HI to Oakland, CA on January 12th.
- In 1929, she helped found the "Ninety-Nines," an international organization of women pilots that still exists today.
- In 1937, Amelia and a navigator tried to fly around the world. On the hardest leg of their journey, their plane vanished near Howland Island in the central Pacific Ocean.
- Some believe that they drowned. Others believe that they were killed or captured by the Japanese. No evidence of either event happening exists.
