- Artists will import video, sound, and graphics into bins for editing in Adobe Premiere
- Artists will organize various assets into separate bins (video, audio, graphics, text)
- Artists will rename, label, and organize their footage for editing.
- Artists will troubleshoot common issues in Premiere and learn to fix issues
- Artists will use 2 video tracks to divide their clips for parallel editing on their video timeline.
- Artists will use multiple tracks to organize sound/adjust levels on a timeline.
- Artists will utilize existing footage along with self-procured audio clips to create a short film
