Instructional Tasks/Activities

- Artist will be introduced to blocking for camera, with action through direct instruction and a short video
- Artist will create their own unique shot list for original genre based film
- · Artist will review set etiquette and professionalism on a film set through teacher lecture
- Artists will act as cast and crew for their film production
- Artists will be given a scene to rehearse and block out in the studio. Once finished, both crew with view the blocking implemented by the other team for critique/review
- Artists will be introduced to filming for coverage, and best practices though lecture, and using examples from an actual film
- Artists will follow scripts and storyboards provided and make decisions and adaptations to keep the production going
- Artists will form 2 crews and film the same scene, covering all shots assigned to them
- Artists will produce a film based on the pre-production work of another class
- Artists will record footage and provide it to the original group for editing.
- Class will be split into two production crews for blocking workshop
