#### **Course Overview**

Sequence- Unit Titles, Summaries, and Number of weeks per unit (approximately 20 weeks)

**UNIT 1: The Art of Storytelling** (8-10 weeks): Using the Writer's Workshop method, students will engage in the writing process to draft, edit, revise, and produce various genre-specific short stories. Students will examine the techniques employed in a collection of short stories and experiment with their own writing as they explore voice, develop complex characters, and produce original pieces to display in a writing portfolio.

**UNIT 2: Lights, Camera, Action** (5 weeks): In this unit, students explore the art of screenplays. Students study a variety of anchor texts to inspire an original screenplay, which they will produce, direct, and present to the class.

**UNIT 3: A Celebration of Words** (4 weeks): Students will end the course by diving into poetry as an artistic form of expression. Students will use various poetic inspirations to craft an original poem. The course ends with a celebration of the spoken word.
