#### **Unit 5: Careers in Art**

Students will continue to learn each Adobe platform, advanced digital tools, and techniques to navigate creating with resources to ultimately design original works of art inspired by artists and art careers in history. Students will be able to research various careers in art and complete an essay with their findings. They will also be able to present their findings to their peers and work within groups to do their presentations. They can then understand the vocabulary and terminology within the career fields of the arts.
