

1. Students should draw the sun in 5 different positions across the boxes. It should be low and to the right in the first box (the sun rises in the east), in the top middle of the third box, and low and to the left in the last box (the sun sets in the west). Teacher discretion allowed. (5 points, 1-ESS1-1)
2. Fall, Winter, Summer, Spring. They do not have to be in any particular order. (4 points, 1-ESS1-2)
3. A. Day (1 point, 1-ESS1-2)
4. A. Phases (1 point, 1-ESS1-1)
5. Students should explain that rotation of the Earth on its axis causes day and night. Teacher discretion allowed. (3 points, 1-ESS1-1)
6. A. True (1 point, 1-ESS1-2)
7. Students should explain that the phases (or appearance) of the moon changes due to the position of the moon in relation to the sun. Teacher discretion allowed. (3 points, 1-ESS1-1)
