Unit Focus

Lesson Summaries

Unit 3 (weeks 12-17)

At the Fire Station- In this lesson, students identify the main idea and supporting details of a text and develop topics with facts and details. Students write thank you notes to community workers. Students demonstrate active listening of oral presentations by asking questions with moderate support. They also use prepositions in simple sentences (noun phrase, action verb, prepositional phrase).

Our Garden in the City- In this lesson, students use language that pertains to sequence and order. They describe topics and include supporting illustrations. They recognize and analyze numerical patterns and rules. Students persuade others in conversations and use the coordinating conjunctions and, or, but, and for to create compound sentences.

Oompah! Oompah!- In this lesson, students analyze how written, verbal, visual, and digital elements contribute to a text. They use figurative language and sensory details to convey experiences. They learn that parade sponsors benefit from publicity. Students also use personification and onomatopoeia.

Stone Soup- In this lesson, students examine characters in a folktale, support opinions about the main character, and explore characters' motives and behavior in other stories. They recite poems to partners and embed clauses to create precise and detailed sentences.

Traveling on an Airplane- In this lesson, students describe the attributes of shapes. They write tour-guide narratives using descriptive details and clear event sequences. They create bar graphs to demonstrate understanding of basic properties of figures. They express ideas using basic modals and use coordinating conjunctions to create compound sentences.

Stacy Zoern: Getting Around on New Wheels- In this lesson, students determine the main idea and supporting details of a text and support opinions with reasons when writing. They write letters to community leaders and create radio advertisements. Students use the simple future tense to convey ideas appropriately.

Unit 3 (weeks 19-21)

Bones- In this lesson, students summarize, paraphrase, and write information about their skeletal systems. They compare vertebrates to nonvertebrates. They express appropriate reasons to support opinions, and they use subordinating conjunctions to create complex sentences.

Look Inside: Your Heart and Lungs- In this lesson, students use text features to learn information, create posters to show they can introduce a topic and group related information, and monitor and record the intensity of exercise. They adjust language choices to create infographics and use linking verbs to convey ideas appropriately.

Look Inside: Your Brain- In this lesson, students use prior knowledge and experience to understand and respond to information about the brain. They write journal entries and thank you letters detailing how the brain helps them. They plan and deliver short oral presentations and learn roots and affixes.
