Cross-Curricular Integration

Integration Area: Language Arts

W.AW.K.1 Use a combination of drawing, dictating, and writing to compose opinion pieces in which they tell a reader the topic or the name of the book they are writing about and state an opinion or preference about the topic or book (e.g., My favorite book is...).

Activity:

The teacher will read aloud Mae Among the Stars by Roda Ahmed and discuss the important message, “If you can dream it, if you believe it, and work hard for it, anything is possible!” Students will complete the sentence, “When I grow up I want to be... because...” and illustrate their writing.

Diversity Integration

The teacher will show two eggs of different colors and students will be asked to describe how the eggs look on the outside. The teacher and students will discuss how the eggs are like people and how this relates to how Martin Luther King Jr. wanted everyone to be treated.
