Content Area(s)/Course/Grade: Library -Second Grade	Unit:Reading for Love and Personal Growth
Lesson Topic: Illustrator Study-Kadir Nelson part 1	Approx. Date/s: Week of Feb. 6, 2023

Textbook, Materials, Resources: Read alouds: Henry's Freedom Box, Coretta Scott, If You Plant a Seed, Pebble Go Article- Kadir Nelson and Biography pyramid handout	
Lesson Objective:	
-The students will use the PebbleGo Biographies database to learn about Kadir Nelson and his contributions to literature.	
Instructional Delivery	
Culturally Responsive Teaching strategy: Tell students that February is Black History Month. In February, people learn how black people throughout history have made great accomplishments despite many challenges, such as not being treated the same as white people. Explain to students that they will learn about an amazing illustrator Kadir Nelson, and his accomplishments, and some of the challenges he faced in his lifetime.	
Procedures: Introduce students to PebbleGo. Demonstrate how to use the database. Show students the sample Biography Pyramid handout. Explain how each section of the pyramid can be completed by using the information from the PebbleGo article. Model how to navigate the PebbleGo Biographies article about Kadir Nelson Demonstrate the read aloud and video features, as well as the timeline section of the article. www.pebblego.com Give each student a Biography Pyramid handout, a pencil, and crayons to complete using the appropriate Kadir Nelson PebbleGo Biographies article. After completing the information on their handout, have students use scissors and glue to assemble their pyramid.	
Assessment/Evaluation	
Students will be assessed on their Biography Pyramid	
Closure: Students will share something they learned about Kadir Nelson with a classmate.
