Practice: One-point Perspective

Activity - Advocating through Art, a theme for their portfolios in 5th grade. Activity: Pointillism Scapes - Cross curricular with the science of color: Divisionism (or chromoluminarism), color mixing and how to achieve maximum luminosity.

Activity: Students will learn a primary hand building technique in ceramics and will successfully build a 4-5 inch coil pot of even thickness with minimal imperfections. They will strengthen their skills and master coil building with the material of clay. Students will be shown a PowerPoint with visual examples of how to build a coil pot step by step, as well as given a live demonstration.
