

Kindergarten June Garden Visit Lesson Plan

Preparing to Harvest the Garden

Objective: Students will be able to determine which parts of plants humans can eat for survival

Standard: K-LS1-1: Use observations to describe patterns of what plants and animals (including humans) need to survive.

Materials:

- Surface to write on (If you wish to complete the worksheet outdoors)
- Pencils
- Plants we eat book

Activities:

- Once arriving in the garden, the teacher(s) can review what plants need to grow and survive.
- The teacher(s) can now ask what humans need to survive. (Food, water, shelter, and air.) The teacher(s) will explain how farmers plant food that they can eat.
- Students can walk through the garden to see what is growing. Teachers can discuss with students what is edible in our garden.
- Students and teachers can read and color the “Plant Parts We Eat” book (found in Google Drive).
- After, students can discuss what they like to eat that grows in nature or a garden.
