Second Grade June Garden Visit Lesson Plan

Objective: Students will be able to compare and contrast a plant and a living animal that survives in the garden habitat.

Standard: LS4.D: Biodiversity and Humans There are many different kinds of living things in any area, and they exist in different places on land and in water.

Materials:

- Garden Venn Diagram
- Surface to write on (If you wish to complete the worksheet outdoors)
- Pencils

Activities:

- Students will think about a plant and animal that survive in the garden habitat.
- The students will then complete the venn diagram to compare and contrast the two living organisms. The students can think about where the living thing lives, how it gets nutrients, etc.
- Students can then share how the two living organisms were similar and different. Students will come to the conclusion that many different kinds of things can live in any area.
