Big Ideas

- Augmentative and Adaptive Communication (AAC)-provide alternative methods of low and high tech modalities of communication to facilitate self-expression and social interaction in a variety of settings.

Cross-Curricular Integration

- Teaching cooking skills as a daily life lesson and for measurement practice.
- Students will learn about community signs during social studies and connect this to reading. Students will need to read signs and state what they mean in regards to their safety. For example, reading the word stop on a stop sign and understanding what it means.
- Students will learn about daily living skills such as brushing their teeth. They will learn the importance of why they need to brush their teeth in health.
